

The E-Hotsheet- The Standard and Custom

When the agent selects Y for the e-Hotsheet the default (includes all the areas of NTREIS) will be sent. To receive an e-hotsheet for just the agent's area she will need to design a custom hotsheet and select yes to email it and turn off the default e-hotsheet.

If you wish to receive the standard e-hotsheet (which includes all areas) click on your name



Please note the different functions:

The Market Area selected under "My Market Areas" affects the Hotsheet on the left side of the Homepage – not the hotsheet that will be automatically emailed every day.

Agent Maintenance

In order to customize your daily emailed hotsheet you must create a custom hotsheet and select the option to email:

Custom E-Hotsheet 🧐

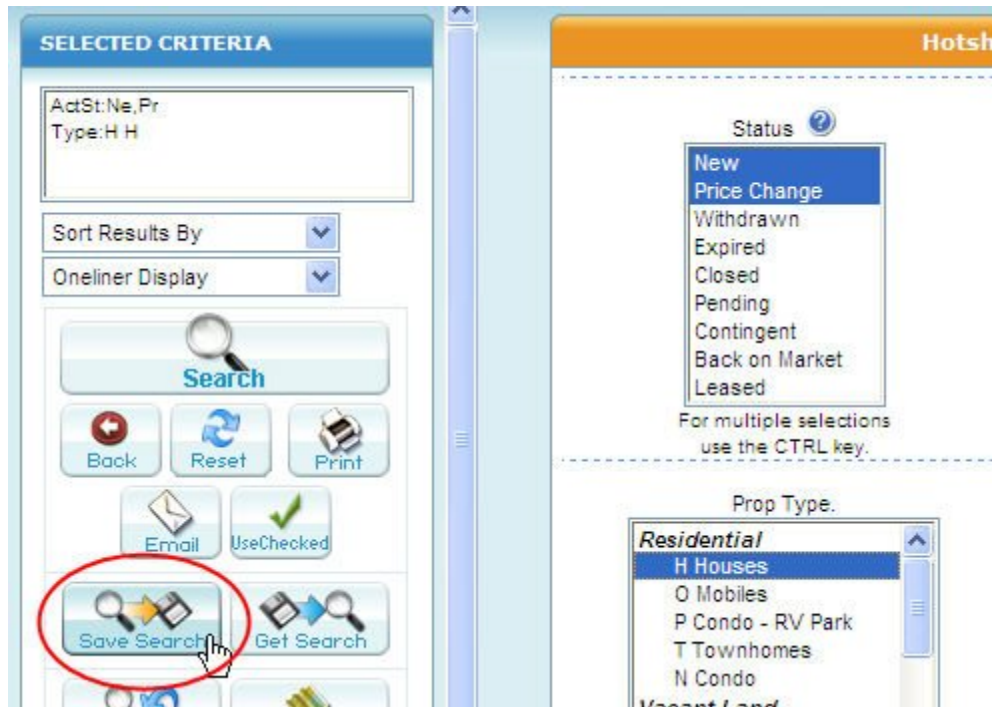
Every morning InnoVia sends the [complete hotsheet](#) to your email address. This hotsheet includes all areas, all property types, and all event types. It is quite possible that some agents do not wish to receive the complete hotsheet, because they only work in particular areas or with particular property types. Agents have the option to discontinue the complete e-hotsheet under Agent Maintenance.

Instead of the complete hotsheet, agents may wish to create their own custom e-hotsheet that will also be received in their email each morning. To create a custom e-hotsheet, complete the following steps:

- Go to the "Hotsheet" section of InnoVia and input the parameters for the hotsheet you would like to receive.



- Do NOT put in an activity date (the system will assume that you want the previous day's events).
- Instead of clicking the "Search" button, click the "Save Search" button on the left side of the screen.



- Give your custom hotsheet a name that you will recognize later if you need to modify it.
- At the bottom of the window, check the "email me" box.
- Click "OK"
